



Dr. Tong Wu received her Ph.D. in molecular genetics from Chinese Academy of Sciences. She then worked at Georgia State University and Ottawa Hospital (Civic Campus) as a post-doctoral fellow. Her research included the development of DNA vaccines and novel vaccine adjuvants. Dr. Wu joined Health Canada as a Senior Scientific Evaluator in 2005 and was responsible for submission review and lot release of vaccines for many years before taking on the management role at one of the Vaccine Quality Divisions. Since 2007, Dr. Wu has served frequently as a WHO Temporary Adviser to support WHO in activities related to vaccines, such as preparation of WHO Guidelines as a drafting group member, dossier review for the pre-qualification program, and presentation at workshops for the implementation of WHO guidelines.
